MEMORANDUM FOR COMMANDER MISSISSIPPI VALLEY DIVISION

SUBJECT: Implementation Guidance for Section 1314 of the Water Resources Development Act of 2016 (WRDA 2016), Red River Below Denison Dam, Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Louisiana

1. Section 1314 of WRDA 16 deauthorized the portion of the Red River Below Denison Dam flood control project authorized by section 10 of the Flood Control Act of 1946 (60 Stat. 647, chapter 596), consisting of the portion of the West Agurs Levee that begins at lat. 32° 32' 50.86" N., by long. 93° 46' 16.82" W., and ends at lat. 32° 31' 22.79" N., by long. 93° 45' 2.47" W. The deauthorization of the West Agurs levee portion of the project was effective on the date of enactment Act, 16 December 2016.
2. Effective 16 December 2016 the West Agurs Levee that begins at lat. 32° 32' 50.86" N., by long. 93° 46' 16.82" W., and ends at lat. 32° 31' 22.79" N., by long. 93° 45' 2.47" W. is no longer a federally authorized component of the Red River Below Denison Dam project, nor is it subject to 33 U.S.C. § 408. The Vicksburg District Commander will notify the non-Federal sponsor in writing that the West Agurs Levee segment has been deauthorized and that the district will no longer inspect the levee.
