Please find attached two project modification submission proposals for the Ouachita-Black Rivers Navigation Project, AR & LA.

The Ouachita-Black Rivers Navigation Project, AR & LA is a navigation channel on the Black and Ouachita Rivers extending 337 miles from the mouth of Black River to Camden, AR. The project consist of four locks and dams and provides a channel with a minimum depth of 9 feet, a minimum bottom width of 100 feet and a minimum radius of 1,000 feet in the channel bends.

These modification requests include the addition of bank stabilization and the lower 14,000 feet of Little River as project features of the Navigation Project.
